
Infrastructure Training and Safety

Reduce Energy Costs

Industrial Assessment Center at Texas A&M (IAC) - Funded by the U.S. Department of Energy, the IAC is a team of professional staff and trained students that conduct free assessments for mid-sized industries to help them stay competitive through reduction of costs. The assessments include energy efficiency and productivity improvements, waste minimization, and pollution prevention.

More than 710 industrial clients have been recipients of energy assessments through IAC, resulting in average annual potential savings of over \$50,000. Their website is iac.tamu.edu.



Workforce Training & Grants

Workforce Solution - As the operating affiliate of the Gulf Coast Workforce Board, Workforce Solutions is the public workforce system in the 13-county Houston-Galveston region. We help employers meet their human resource needs and individuals build careers, so both can compete in the global economy.

On-the-Job Training (OJT) offers participants an opportunity to earn as they learn, while employers benefit from a partial wage reimbursement during the training period. OJT focuses on jobs that involve new technologies, production, service or additional skills for full-time positions (30 hours per week is considered full-time) paying at least \$10.00 per hour or more.
